



Pre-existing health conditions are associated with 18.8% of all incidents in the National Incident Dataset

The figure below shows the most frequently identified contributory factors, and relationships between factors, associated with incidents involving a pre-existing condition.

Example pre-existing conditions

Illness:

- Asthma
- Allergies
- Cold & Flu
- Migraines
- Menstruation

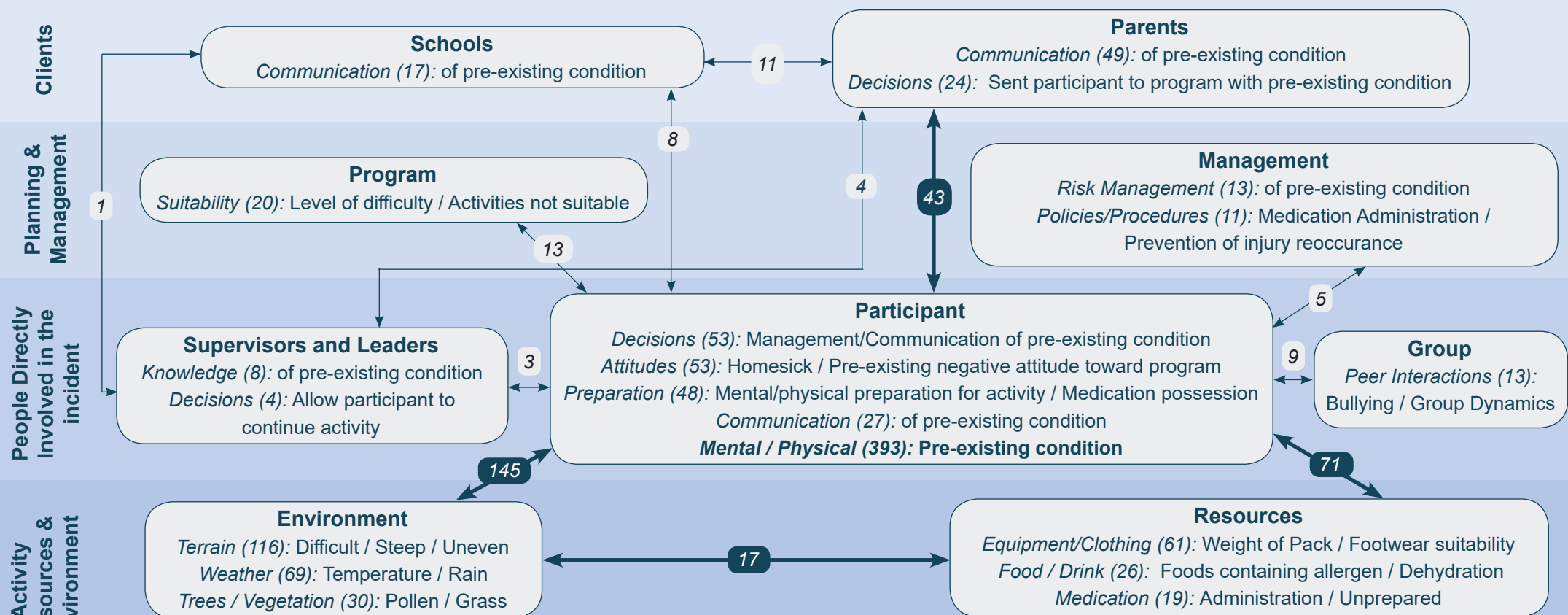
Psychosocial:

- Anxiety
- Depression
- Trauma
- Behavioural Issues

Injury:

- Muscular
- Sprain
- Fracture
- Blister
- Ingrown Toenail

Note: No contributory factors identified at the Government, Education and Regulation Levels



The values in brackets represent the number of times a contributory factor was identified.

The values on the lines indicate the number of times a relationship was identified. Dark lines represent the most frequent relationships.
